EQUIPMENT
On 2 floors, the rooms (11 m <sup>2</sup> ) consist of basic furniture (bed, desk, wardrobes), a shower, a sink and a toilet.
Each room has an internet connection.
COMMUNAL AREAS
A whole floor includes an equipped shared kitchen, a dining room, a large room for relaxation and study, terraces (including a vegetated one). In addition, this floor has WIFI. In the basement, a laundry room (automatic machine, electric dryer, ironing board and iron) is available to students.
COST
About 300 €/month.
This price includes: accommodation (7 days / week) and full board (5 days / week), as well as a breakfast during the 2 days of the W-E.
