Men and women's dorms are separate. There are two kitchens that have induction cookers and dining lounges along with microwaves, toasters and large coolers/refrigerators in Global Village.

Students can bring their own insurance that covers for 2 months after arrival. Korean National Health Insurance gets effective after student's alien registration and this will be done about 2 months after arrival.
